# CFATS Compliance – Your Site Security Plan

This next step in the CFATS compliance progression is potentially the most critical, as it will become the basis of DHS's audit of each facility.

- Deter, Detect, and Delay an Attack on your facility.
- Prevent Theft and Diversion of potentially dangerous chemicals.
- Mitigate the risk of internal Sabotage, and
- Achieve a satisfactory level of security to meet the **15 other published Risk Based Performance Standards (RBPS)**.

## CFATS Impact on Your Company

---

Completing your Site Security Plan will be a very labor intensive process (DHS estimates 200 or more hours).

Having “guards, gates and guns” is not enough to make you compliant. The RBPS requirements have an intense focus on the FUNCTION of the security measures; not simply their presence.

You will only have 120 days from the assignment of your final tier to the submission of your plan.
