## SVA Overview

The new Security Vulnerability Assessment (**SVA**) was created by the Department of Homeland Security (**DHS**) to evaluate vulnerabilities, threats and consequences to your facility.

Based on your Top Screen, you have received your preliminary DHS classification rank.

The top three tiers (Tier 1/Tier 2/Tier 3) must use the DHS online tool to complete their SVA. Tier 4 facilities can submit a comparable SVA methodology, such as the Center for Chemical Process Safety (**CCPS**).

## SVA Process

High risk facilities (Tiers 1 through 3) require the SVA which includes the following structure:

- Characterization of the Facility
- Assessment of Threat
- Vulnerability Analysis
- Risk Assessments
- Countermeasure Analysis

This thorough process typically consists of 3 to 5 days onsite. During the SVA, you will create some Chemical-terrorism Vulnerability Information (**CVI**), which will involve keeping the SVA secured at a classified level.
